Hugh Hewitt is a nationally-renowned lawyer, law professor, and broadcast journalist whose nationally syndicated radio show is heard in more than 120 cities across the United States every weekday afternoon.

A highly-respected legal and political commentator, Mr. Hewitt has been a frequent guest on CNN, NBC, ABC, CBS, and Fox News Network, and has written for The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, and the Los Angeles Times.

He is also the author of more than a dozen books, including two New York Times best-sellers. He served as a panelist for two of the 2015 GOP presidential candidate debates and will participate in additional debates in 2016. He has received three Emmys for his work as co-host of the ground-breaking Life & Times program, a nightly news and public affairs program that aired from 1992 until 2007.
